

Missed Concert Make-Up Assignment

Concert performances are an integral part of the music curriculum. They are critical to learning musicianship, ensemble and performance practice. There are no excused absences from concert performances and there is no way to re create the concert experience. However, in the event that a performer is sick, or has a conflict that can in no way be resolved, the following assignment must be completed. This assignment is a required make-up for a missed concert.

All three parts of this assignment need to be handed in no later than 10 school days following the missed performance

*****Record all pieces that would be performed at the concert on email or CD.

**Check with your director

*****Complete the reflection paper on the back of this sheet.

*****Your completed assignments must also be accompanied with the parent excuse note below.

Reflection Question Procedure

1. Go to the Duxbury Music Department Website and download the concert recording
 - a. www.Duxburymusic.net
 - b. On the welcome page is a link to the Duxbury Music Media page
 - c. This page can be found directly at <http://duxburymusic.net/home/duxbury-media/>
 - d. The password is 'Music'
 - e. Click on Duxbury Media and Recordings, then the folder marked DHS or DMS Concerts. Depending on your group.
 - f. Inside this folder, find the folder containing the recording for the concert that you missed.
 - g. Find the Recording, download it and listen to it in its entirety
2. Listen to the concert and write a 2 page paper on the question below
 - a. This paper should be a typed, 2 page paper, double spaced, with proper APA or MLA formatting

Reflection Question

How was your ensemble's live concert performance different from your perception of the piece in rehearsals?

Be sure to include the composer's musical intentions, how the group performed those intentions and how you heard them on the recording. Some quick Internet research can help you to make your point better.

Submit your paper, recordings and signed note to your music director no later than 10 school days after the missed concert.
